Comments	<p>I certainly object to potentially Loxwood ClayPits Ltd plan for a commercial waste recycling plant and associated clay pits sited near Loxwood on the grounds of:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The effect on the environment - increasing carbon emissions, increasing Water stress [already a highly stressed area].</li><li>2. This is an area of ancient woodland which would lose a huge amount of natural habitat.</li><li>3. The site is a Greenfield site and not Brownfield [which it should be] for such an enterprise.</li><li>4. Huge increase by HGV's to and from the site on minor roads.The Loxwood Road is a restricted width carriageway.</li><li>5. There is no need for more clay as reserves are good enough.</li><li>6. Existing capacity for Construction and Demolition waste is already adequate and more suitably situated.</li><li>7. This is totally out of kilter with the Loxwood Neighbourhood plan or the Chichester District Local Plan in a rural area.</li><li>8. The plan involves Intrusion, noise, pollution of a remote and tranquil area.</li></ol>
