Comments	<p>This is possibly one of the most ridiculous planning applications I've ever had the misfortune to read. It is completely unsuitable for a variety of reasons, namely :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) There is simply no demand for a clay site as other national and local requirements are being met with great ease.</li><li>2) There is no justification for a waste site.</li><li>3) Being a greenfield site and is in direct contrast to national policy waste sites should be located in more 'built up' areas.</li><li>4) There is a significant loss of amenity with the closing of a footpath and with prevailing winds the noise and air pollution towards a local school is unacceptable.</li><li>5) This application is in direct contravention to the Loxwood Neighbour hood Plan and Chichester District Local Plan.</li><li>6) The increased traffic will have a severe impact on the surrounding local villages and the road infrastructure simply cannot take the proposed 42 HGV truck movements daily.</li></ol>
