There is a 25 year supply of clay in at least 3 pits and 24 year supply in another therefore the national and local level clay requirements are met. The natural habitat for many species of animals will be eradicated and four threatened species of bats have been found to live in the trees on this site. It will have major devastating impact on all creatures that live here. The impact on the roads will be immense. Already the narrow roads around this site are dangerous at times. Horses, cyclists and all vehicle users lives will be put at risk because of the size and frequency of the proposed traffic.
