Comments	<p>Having lived in the area for 16 years I strongly object to the development of a clay pit and recycling plant on the grounds that it is a greenfield site and as such goes against National Policy that states that waste sites should be developed on brownfield sites. It is also a fact that there is no demand for Clay in the area and thus it is economically non-viable to transport clay over any distance. Increased traffic(over a 33 year period) will have a severe impact on the surrounding local villages, Alfold Bars,Loxwood, Rudgwick Tismans Common and Barns Green. This carries a risk of highway safety as the road is only 5.1 m wide at its narrowest point. There are many listed building in the area which would be potentially damaged by the constant traffic of HGV's.</p> <p>The impact on the environment would be catastrophic, with loss of wild life, damage to ancient woodland and an increase in net carbon emissions.</p> <p>Perhaps most emotive but equally important particularly in these strange times is the impact upon the natural environment, which has been proven to have a beneficial effect on both children and adults who use the woods daily for dog walks and exercise.</p> <p>There are at least 10 valid reasons why this development is entirely unacceptable ranging from noise, pollution,impact on natural environment to suitability of use and effect on the character of the area, as such I strongly object to the application.</p>
