Comments	I strongly object to the planning proposal for a clay quarry and recycling facility on the Loxwood Road, for a number of reasons. The location is completely unsuitable for this type of facility, has absolutely no benefit to the local community and would negatively impact the local area. Continuous HGV traffic along the Loxwood road would cause major issues for local residents from constant noise and disruption. The existing B road is narrow and not suitable for supporting this volume of HGV traffic and would also increase safety risks for all other road users. This is a village/country location and the traffic would dramatically increase - and heavily increase the traffic pollution also. The site itself is a beautiful unspoilt woodland area home to wildlife and well used by walkers, cyclists and horse riders, and local to farmland. It is a greenfield site and should NOT be used for this type of development. It would have an extremely negative impact on the landscape and character of the local area. Footpaths would also be closed and/or compromised throughout and the proposed building structure would have a significant negative impact on the area, as well as adding light pollution to an otherwise unspoilt natural location.
