Comments	<p>I strongly object to this application on various grounds.</p> <p>It is not a suitable use of the area. It is a greenfield site of ancient woodland with diverse habitats including protected bats and mature trees. We should cherish these sites. National policy states waste sites should be sited in brownfield sites. This is not brownfield.</p> <p>The environmental impact of this development would be a disaster! Felling of trees, loss of habitat an increase in carbon emissions and pollutants from Hgv's combined with the loss of trees). Noise pollution, dust and contaminants which could end up in the water course.</p> <p>The increase in HGVs will have a massive impact on the local villages. The roads are too narrow and bendy, and would cause a severe safety risk to walkers, horse riders cyclists and runners who frequent all these roads and nearby footpaths and bridleways. The HGVs will also damage country lanes causing even more pot holes and even more danger to road users including pedestrians.</p> <p>There will be loss of amenity as HGVs will run along established public rights of way, it will close well used and enjoyed footpaths. There will be noise and pollution is what is currently a beautiful tranquil area.</p> <p>There is no justification for this site. The WSCC Mineral Monitoring report states there is no demand for brick-making clay as there are more than 25 years of reserves and there is already sufficient capacity for construction and demolition waste in West Sussex.</p>
