Comments	<p>I object to this applications for following reasons:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. West Sussex already have existing clay extraction sites which more than meets both National and local level requirements.2. There is currently sufficient capacity for construction waste in West Sussex3. The applicant's plan is to only recycle 50% of the waste bought into the plant which is well below recommended industrial standard4. This is a greenfield site, National policy states waste sites should be located in Brown field sites5. The proposed sites runs across establish public rights of way and public footpaths6. Application is not sensitive to local setting and does not bring any benefits to the local community7. The application has not taken into account the damage it will bring to the local Environment, including ancient woodland and wild life.8. Increased HGV traffic will have a severe impact on an already stressed local road network with increased congestion as well as Highway safety issues8. Increased traffic will have severe impact on local communities which can only be resolved by significant investment in the local road network.9.
