Comments	This ancient woodland is vital for the local area and we must save it for future generations. It is a well used footpath and bridleway. The local wildlife habitat should be a major factor in precluding this application. The four threatened bat species alone which are so rare marks this out as a Area of Special Scientific Interest. Climate change and environmental logic should also negate the selection of this site. The WSCC Minerals Monitoring Report states there are already 25 years of brick making reserves. Why is this application being made? It is clearly not for clay but for future development as housing to make the rich richer. This area is not sustainable as a Waste Site - the plan is to only recycle 50% of waste brought on to site. This does not balance off the increased HGV movements on minor roads affecting small villages and causing potential conflict with HGV and local traffic including cyclists pedestrians and horses with a potential loss of life on roads. There are also major conflicts with usage of neighbouring farmland.;
