Comments	<p>I am writing to object to this proposed development at Pallinghurst Woods. This will have a huge impact on the local environment and residents in an area I have strong ties - both from family and from being married in the local church in Rudgwick in 2017.</p> <p>My objection is based on the following points:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Traffic and Safety - the increased HGV traffic will have a huge impact on safety in the area. The Lockwood Road has direct access housing with young and elderly residents, and is commonly used by walkers, cyclists, and horses alike. The safety of this narrow road with the addition of these vehicles I do not believe has been fully assessed both for residents and road users.</li><li>2. Environment and Sustainability - in a world of increased focus on climate change and our impact on the environment, building a waste site in a greenfield location and increasing claypit capacity at a location not close to local brickworks and when the demand for it is not there should not be justifiable and should be immediately reviewed for its irreversible ecological impact. The environmental impact to the local wildlife and the increased net carbon emissions from the tree felling and operational activities of this site should be further reviewed to assess for its necessity versus the damage it will cause to the local area.</li><li>3. Tranquility and Pollutants - this location is a beautiful part of West Sussex much loved by its residents and non-locals for its peacefulness. The impact of both the development and the huge traffic increase in terms of noise pollution will be intrusive and life changing, plus the ongoing impact of other pollutants such as dust, mud, and light have not been fully assessed for their impact to the health - both physical and mental of the local residents or the damage to the local environment above and beyond the initial impact - this has not been fully assessed or referenced.</li><li>4. Effect on Character of Area - the proposed development will have an irreversible impact on the area's character - not only for loss of trees, wildlife impact and increase of traffic as mentioned, but also the impact on public right of ways and footpaths, popular dog walking areas for both residents and those in the surrounding areas, and in general the creation of an unsightly development not in keeping with the natural beauty of the area as it is today.</li></ol> <p>Finally, this development will not enhance or compliment its environment or bring any demonstrable benefit to the local community, and as such should be strongly objected against and reviewed in it's entirety.</p> <p>Yours Sincerely, Philip Sanday</p>
