This area is a remote and tranquil space where many people enjoy walking, hearing bird song and just generally soaking up all that nature has to offer. We are blessed to have such beautiful surroundings and the thought of introducing HGV lorries with the pollution and noise disturbance they will bring feels incredibly sad and counterintuitive to modern environmental thinking. The increased traffic and highway safety issues from the HGVs entering and exiting is a worry added to by the route being quite narrow in places which is an increased risk to other road users and pedestrians.

According to the latest WSCC Minerals Monitoring Report there is no demand for additional brick making clay and there are sufficient reserves. My understanding is that the trend is to consolidate local brick making rather than open new brickworks. Therefore without the demand it seems that this proposal and the destruction and disruption it will create are wholly preposterous and I very much object.
