Comments	<p>I totally object to this application on the following grounds:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. It has been proven that the demand for clay has reduced and that existing supplies are sufficient for the next 25 years.2. There is already sufficient capacity for demolition and construction waste at more suitable current sites.3. This is a Greenfield site and national policy states that brownfield sites or sites in built up areas should be used.4. Wildlife would be driven from this area including protected species.5. Public rights of way will be compromised and public safety put at risk. Existing Public footpaths would be redirected for the next 33 years!6. The application is not included on the local or county development plans.7.
