## Dear Sirs

I wish to object in the strongest possible terms to the proposal referred to in the above application, on the following bases:

- 1. There is no need for any further clay production, because the existing capacity is more than sufficient.
- 2. The increase in lorry traffic will severely reduce the safety of the local road network, and will result in a large increase in repair work for which the County, and ultimately the ratepayers will pay.
- 3. This development is sited in a greenfield area which should be protected.
- 4. There is no need for any increase in waste disposal facilities in the area.

I should point out that there is much local experience of increased lorry traffic, associated with a smaller operation at Crouchlands Farm, which was eventually stopped by Council action, on the grounds that it was illegal.
