Dear Sirs

I wish to object in the strongest possible terms to the proposal referred to in the above application, on the following bases:

1. There is no need for any further clay production, because the existing capacity is more than sufficient.
2. The increase in lorry traffic will severely reduce the safety of the local road network, and will result in a large increase in repair work for which the County, and ultimately the ratepayers will pay.
3. This development is sited in a greenfield area which should be protected.
4. There is no need for any increase in waste disposal facilities in the area.

I should point out that there is much local experience of increased lorry traffic, associated with a smaller operation at Crouchlands Farm, which was eventually stopped by Council action, on the grounds that it was illegal.
