Comments	<p>As per the WSCC Minerals Monitoring Report, there is no demand for additional brickmaking clay and therefore this is all about making money from the waste materials from construction sites. This will create additional noise, dust and pollutants in what is a tranquil woodland enjoyed by thousands of people in the local area. I for one walk my dog in these woods multiple times per week which helps with my physical and mental wellbeing. The thought of having noisy diesel generators, machinery and lorries disturbing these ancient woodlands is unacceptable.</p> <p>This development does not conform to the Loxwood Neighbourhood Plan or the Chichester District Local Plan for development in rural area. What is the point in us creating these plans to protect our villages and surrounding outdoor space if they are not adhered to!</p> <p>Another concern is the safety impact the 42 lorry movements per day will have to the narrow road from the layby to Bucks Green. The first mile of this route is narrow and is tight for two cars passing, let alone lorries. My wife and I use this road frequently to travel to the surrounding villages/towns and this presents a serious risk to our safety. The other concern here is the mud and water transported from the site to the road outside. This is on a tight corner which will create a skid risk for cars and bikes as well as ice in the winter months.</p>
