Comments	<input type="text" value="This ancient woodland must be saved for future generations. It is a well-used footpath and bridleway and the local wildlife habitat should play a major factor in precluding this application. Just on their own merit the four threatened rare bat species mark this out as an Area of Special Scientific Interest. The WSCC Minerals Monitoring Report states there are already 25 years of brick making reserves so I fail to understand why is this application is even being made? It is clearly not for the clay but I wouldn't mind betting that a future housing development is not too far round the corner! In addition, this area is also not sustainable as a Waste Site with the plan being to only recycle 50% of waste brought on to site. This does not justify the increased HGV movements on minor roads affecting the small surrounding villages and which will inevitably cause potential conflict between the HGVs and local traffic including cyclists, pedestrians and horses."/>
