Loss of car parking at lay by on Loxwood Road Safety for my dog and grandchildren when walking in a large part of the woods due to vehicle activity. The impact will be immense on our lovely natural environment and wildlife in ancient woodland The area proposed is a greenfield site, which I thought was never to be disturbed by projects such as waste sites, nor is this included in the Chichester District Plan for development in a rural area.
