Comments	<p>I strongly object to the submitted plan for multiple reasons:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Destruction of tranquility - this is in a rural location and there is little to no background noise - these works would destroy that tranquility that we all expect in this location.</li><li>2. The tranquility will be further destroyed by the multiple Lordy movements that would be expected with such a facility. Apart from the noise and nuisance of lorries in tiny country lanes the local Infrastructure can simply not cope with the amount and nature of the intended movements.</li><li>3. As horse riders that ride through this exact area we will be at massively increased risk from the lorry movements .</li><li>4. There is no need for extra clay. Local clay outs have been closed down due to lack of demand - indeed prof of lack of demand was a condition to change of use of previous clay put in the area.</li><li>5. This is a greenfield site not suitable for a waste site - there are plenty of better places brown field sites for such a use.</li><li>6. These a woodlands that we have enjoyed riding, walking and running through for the last 8 years enjoying the vast array of wildlife within them and this would be a total unnecessary destruction of such a wonderful habitat..</li><li>7. This is not an environmentally friendly development in a remote and rural area.</li></ol>
