Comments	<p>I wish to object to this application most strongly. The location is totally unsuitable as it is a greenfield site and it is contrary to National Policy that waste sites should be on brownfield sites and should be sited in built up areas. The proposed development would cause significant harmful impacts on the local very rural environment. Moreover it is contrary to the Chichester District Local Plan and the Loxwood Neighbourhood Plan and is not sensitive in any way to the local environment.</p> <p>There is no demand for brick making clay as WSCC have more than 25 years of reserves and there is currently sufficient capacity for construction and demolition waste in West Sussex at established locations which are far more suitable.</p> <p>The location is remote and tranquil and this development will seriously impact that tranquility. The noise from HGV movements & skip lorries will do irreparable damage creating significant noise disturbance.</p> <p>Environmentally it will be a disaster as it will increase carbon emissions at a time when the Government are urging us to reduce those emissions to meet net zero targets. It will also massively impact the local wildlife habitat and species.</p> <p>The increase in HGV traffic will also have a severe impact on local villages such as Rudgwick where I live and there will be an unacceptable number of daily traffic movements by some significant percentage. There will be an acute impact on highway safety along the Loxwood Road which is very narrow and presents a huge risk for pedestrians and other road users.</p> <p>The proposed development must be rejected on all the above grounds and moreover it does nothing to enhance, protect or compliment the natural environment.</p>
