Comments	<p>I strongly object to this application. National policy states that waste sites should be built on brownfield sites, not on greenfield sites as this is. Therefore the proposal is unsuitable for the area. Clay reserves exist in the County and the applicant has not demonstrated any need for additional resources. This commercial / industrial activity will create noise, dust and pollution in an area with little or none currently. Diesel generators, diesel HGVs for transporting the waste products and lighting - all impacting habitats and the wider environment where currently there is no activity just nature. The Loxwood Road to the site is unsuitable for such a frequency of use by HGVs, I often have to slow down and take care when driving for non motorised users of the road. They have a right to use the road as much as anyone. The sheer number of HGVs proposed would be an accident waiting to happen. It isn't lit, has no footpaths and is very narrow and windy along its length. The applicants proposal would create safety issues for all users of the woodland due to multiple, daily HGVs crossing over and passing alongside public rights of way. The character of this very rural and tranquil area would be blighted by the application and it appears there is little or no benefit to the local community and many disadvantages. I trust that the County Planning team will reject this application.</p>
