Comments	<p>How can this area possibly be suitable for an industrial site! The woodland is in the heart of the countryside, only accessed by narrow country lanes. It's beautiful, peaceful, filled with wildlife, and trees that have taken decades, in some cases much longer, to mature. How can one even consider destroying all this natural beauty. The proposed access is on a bend in the road not to mention the tricky access in Rudgwick onto the A281. The area is already under severe pressure, one only has to drive through Loxwood and Alfold to see the various housing developments under construction. Can our narrow roads happily cope with yet more heavy large HGV traffic? I think not. What about cyclists, horses and their riders, walkers (and dogs), runners, pedestrians - they should all be taken into account. We live in an area of twisting narrow roads and small villages (this is the countryside!), an increase in traffic will almost certainly result in more accidents (has anyone noticed the increase in speed of much of the traffic whizzing down the straight stretches from the A281 Crossways to Alfold and Loxwood?). Consider too the impact on residents local to this application - the noise, the dust - not for a few months but YEARS!</p> <p>Finally, is it even needed?
