Comments	<p>I object to the Loxwood Clay Pits Planning Application on 2 main grounds:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Suitability of location and loss of ancient and other woodland The planet faces the enormous challenge of Climate Change. We are told we are currently experiencing the hottest temperatures ever this summer. Forests and woodlands help mitigate this. They are the worlds lungs. We should not be cutting down these amenities in quiet rural areas to allow large industrial units to be built with all the pollution that comes with them. West Sussex must do its bit to help fight off climate change and maintain as sustainable enviroment as possible for residents and visitors alike.</li><li>2. Considerable increase in traffic on small, unsuitable country roads. There will be a large number of lorries in and out of the site. All the surrounding roads are narrow and 2 way traffice will be difficult in many areas. This substantially increases the potential for accidents and will increase noise levels. The centre of Loxwood is already adversely affected by through traffic to the A281 and none of the surrounding areas roads are built to cope with large numbers of additional lorry movements. There seems little justification for this development as it appears there is enough local clay and waste site facilities in the area and the price to pay for this unnecessary development in destruction of local amenities is far too high.</li></ol>
