Comments	<p>I and my three young children take great joy in walking in Pallinghurst Woods. If the clay pits are allowed to go ahead the damage caused to the woods will be irreversible and of great detriment to the wildlife in the area. The large HGV movement through the woods will be crossing public footpaths, making walking with children and dogs hazardous and unsafe.</p> <p>The location is wholly unsuitable for a clay pit and waste recycling plant, with access obtained through pristine woodland and across multiple public footpaths. The nearest main road is over 4km away from the site and the high HGV traffic would be unsuitable for the roads in the area and greatly impact on the tranquility of the area.</p> <p>The demand for clay is non existent and the planning submission only appears to have been made to allow for a waste site to also be sited. Waste sites should be sited on brown field sites in built up areas as per National policy, not in pristine woodlands which are enjoyed by many and an essential environment for wildlife.</p>
