Comments	Proposed application for recycling plant and clay pit in Pallinghurst Woods is a very poorly thought out location for such an operation, as there is no infrastructure in place to run any commercial operation. The owners of the property are not in possession of the mineral rights to extract clay. The road network to the site is unsuitable for a large number of lorry movements. To access the site they would have to cross privately owned farm land that they only have right of access over and the number of lorry movements across this ground would seem excessive compared to previous use. The lorry movement will intrude on farming practice as the access point is situated between two fields which are regularly used for grazing cattle. Transporting clay via roads is financially unviable, plus there is no market this has been demonstrated by the closure of several local brickworks within the local area, despite having large reserves of clay left in their pits. Lorries will have to cross two footpaths and a bridal way to access the site which will put riders, pedestrians, and dogs at risk. The noise dust and pollution that will be created at the site will stress local wildlife as these woods are home to many, deer, badgers, foxes, buzzards, songbirds and many more. If permission is granted this would a devastating blow to the local area and will affect everyone who lives within the local area.
