Comments	<p>I STRONGLY object to the application</p> <p>I now live in London, but my childhood was spent in Rudgwick. On many occasions I walked in the Pallinghurst Woods. I regularly visit my parents in Rudgwick and would be horrified if the application was approved.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. There is no requirement for a new, small-scale, supply of brick-making clay in Sussex.</li><li>2. Waste recycling is well-catered for in Sussex.</li><li>3. The HGV traffic on the woodland track to access the operational site would, very dangerously, share space with, cross over, and be very close to many footpaths and bridleways.</li><li>4. The narrow, undulating and winding Loxwood Road would see a huge and dangerous increase in HGV traffic if the application is approved.</li><li>5. The woods are currently very quiet and tranquil, with virtually no unnatural noise which would be replaced by a considerable number of noisy fixed and movable pieces of machinery, some operating 24/7.</li><li>6. Creation and maintenance of the operational facility will represent environmental vandalism of the worst sort.</li></ol> <p>I very much look forward to hearing that the application has been rejected.</p>
