Comments	<p>I submit this objection as the West Sussex Area Footpath Officer for the Ramblers and also on behalf of the West Sussex Area Countryside Officer for Ramblers.</p> <p>Many other objectors have already commented on the disastrous effect this application would have in the proposed development area, especially the prolonged adverse landscape and visual impacts on the walking environment, particularly BW3240, FP795, FP792 and FP792-1. The specific objections and comments raised by the WSCC Public Rights of Way Department are fully supported by Ramblers and I am sure by all other PROW users. For this reason, I am not intending to repeat them in detail but would wish to raise a further matter for consideration. As part of a project named "2026 - Don't Lose Your Way" Ramblers are currently identifying Rights of Way which exist but were not included on Definitive Maps when they were originally drawn up. A number of these "lost" RoWs have been identified within Pallinghurst Woods including one through the proposed site of the recycling facility and applications are being submitted to have them included on the Definitive Map.</p> <p>The number of objections already received indicates that we are not alone in considering that this proposed development is completely unsuitable for this delightful unspoilt area of countryside and we confirm our strong objection to the application.</p>
