Comments	<p>The use of a peaceful, rural greenfield site incorporating ancient woodland for the proposed use that is suited to an industrial estate (brownfield site) is a nonsense.</p> <p>Anyone living and walking in the woodlands in this area know that background noise levels here are low. The proposed development would dramatically increase local traffic. HGVs would bring increased noise and pollution from vehicle fumes and dust to local residents, the woodland environment and wildlife living there.</p> <p>This is a rural area and as soon as semi industrialised activities are introduced in such a location it is almost inevitable the area will become blighted.</p> <p>I understand that there is no demand for brickmaking clay at present so mining clay here seems arbitrary.</p> <p>The decision to construct a building in the middle of no-where just to bring recyclable items, only to be sorted and carried away again also seems arbitrary. Why bring mess, noise and disturbance to a beautiful area? Industrial estates, or old run down brownfield sites are the places for this sort of activity. Our countryside is such a precious commodity. Ancient woodlands deserve to be kept as such and not ruined for short term gain. It's too easy to damage the environment because of lack of care in researching a suitable location for such activities. Good planning equates to the prevention of misery for the majority including our beautiful wildlife and countryside too.</p>
