Comments	<p>I wish to object to this application wholeheartedly! As a born-and-bred resident of Loxwood I am very passionate about the village and do not wish this beautiful woodland to be desecrated.</p> <p>Increased traffic flow of HGVs along our very narrow roads would have a severe effect to existing road users ...car drivers, cyclists, walkers and particulalry horseriders. The roads were not built to cope with this type of movement and the actual villages would suffer huge safety risks whilst Loxwood Clay Pit vehicles access/leave the site.</p> <p>The location is currently an area of tranquility, allowing birdsong to abound, protected species of bats to reside together with other woodland creatures. No light pollution is currently evident and I wish this to remain so. The use of generators would cause pollution and noise and we do NOT want this to be happening to our woodland which, would involve the felling of a number of mature trees.</p> <p>The proposed site is adjacent to established farming activity which would result in conflict and is in a totally inappropriate location. As friends of people who live very close to the edge of the woodland where the proposed site is, and have done so for practically all of their lives, why should this beautiful piece of landscape be desecrated to allow for excessive noice and pollutution?</p> <p>This is a greenfield site and waste sites should be sited in brownfield sites ....an area of natural beauty should not be ruined by anyone!</p>
