Comments	<p>I live in Bucks Green, an area that will be highly affected by the proposed Clay Pit due to the anticipated traffic volumes along quiet, narrow country roads which are entirely unsuitable for use by HGVs making multiple journeys each day. This will cause delays, noise and air pollution to the hamlet of Bucks Green, Rudgwick and Tismans Common and have a significant negative impact on us and other people who live here. I believe it's also extremely dangerous to have a large number of HGVs using these roads with a high risk of accidents.</p> <p>The area of the proposed clay pit is beautiful, peaceful and much-loved by local people who enjoy walking their dogs and allowing their children to play safely surrounded by nature. On regular walks there I have seen deer, foxes, rabbits and many types of bird life - and I understand there are also badgers living in there. The development will have a significant negative impact on wildlife and the tranquility of the area, as well as causing pollution and a huge increase in carbon emissions. It will turn a pristine woodland into a noisy, dirty, polluting clay pit for which there is no actual need, with West Sussex County Council already having a 25 year reserve supply of clay.</p> <p>This is a Greenfield site, entirely unsuitable for the intended use and with only negative impacts on the local environment and the people who live here.</p>
