I wish to object to Loxwood Clay Pits Ltd Planning Application in Pallinghurst Woods WSCC/030/21

Having lived in Loxwood for some 40 years I have regularly walked these Ancient Woodlands and appreciate their calming affect on my wellbeing. If the proposed development goes ahead, this area will no longer be a haven for wildlife.

I understand the National Policy states that waste sites should be sited in built up areas or brownfield sites. NOT rural Ancient Woodland.

The extra HGV lorries using the B2133 and Station Road will be unbearable for Loxwood residents. This B2133 road already suffers very high volumes of HGV Traffic which is damaging local properties and the general environment.

The risk to pedestrians walking this road which has inadequate or non-existent footpaths, will eventually lead to serious accidents, as HGV's create a massive disturbance when travelling at speed. The road is just not suitable and would require constant repairs
