Several reasons that this is a n unacceptable application. We regularly spend time in this beautiful part of West Sussex staying at Riverside Farm. The roads in this area are hazardous and require careful driving as it is, adding HGVs to this and the possibility of them passing through the small villages are likely to result in accidents. These roads also contain many cyclists and does not bode well for passing them!!
