Comments	I strongly object to the proposed Commercial Waste Recycling Plant and Claypit Development at Pallinghurst Woods, Loxwood, West Sussex for the following reasons:	
	Reason 1 - Road Safety. The narrow Country lanes in this area and surrounding villages are simply not fit for HGVs, leave alone 42 HGV truck movements a day. These lanes are used by Horse Riders, Cyclists, Walkers, Families with Children and Dogs, Children from School Buses walking home, all these have been disregarded in the application which has not looked at things from a safety aspect.
