Objection

I am a member of the Happy Landings RDA group that uses the roads that will be ruined by heavy lorries should this be approved. I am also a keen walker and love this beautiful woodland with its abundance of wildlife. There is no demand for additional brick making clay - WSCC have more than 25 years of reserves. Without the mineral site there is no justification for a waste site at this unsuitable location. There is currently sufficient capacity for construction and demolition waste in West Sussex in established locations that are far more suitable. This is a greenfield site - National policy states that waste sites should be sited in built up areas or brownfield sites. The application includes a 15,000 sq ft building amid pristine and ancient woodlands. Site access for HGV's will run on alongside and across pubic right of way routes regularly used by members of the public. They will close one of the footpaths for 33 years. There will be an increase in net carbon emmisssions and it will have a major impact of local wildlife and species. The increase in HGV traffic will have a severe impact on the local villages. There will be significant increase in HGV traffic volumes along Loxwood road presenting a severe safety risk of existing road users. Loxwood road has a restricted width carriageway
