Comments	<p>4 main reasons to object: The scheme is ill founded. There is no demand for clay in the vicinity There is significant loss of amenity It increase CO2 level There are two flaws in the transport statement: 1.6. The Guildford Road is subject to a 30 mph speed limit and visibility at the Loxwood Road / A281 junction is in accordance with Manual for Streets. The junction geometry is also such that the junction can accommodate the turning requirements of the vehicles likely to be associated with this operation. This is not the case And 3.6. It is recognised that the most direct route to the strategic highway network (A24) is to the east. Whilst this would allow two lorries to pass one another, some caution would be required. The width of Loxwood Road has been measured in strategic locations and for the majority of its length it varies in width, but for the main it is in excess of 5.5m. There is a small section of Loxwood Road west of Exfold Farm that narrows to 5.1m for a distance of some 80.0m. Whilst this would allow two lorries to pass one another, some caution would be required. This section is straight however with excellent forward visibility. The bridge over the stream at (what3words) variety.motored.surprised will neither allow two lorries to pass nor support the weight of increased HGV movements</p>
