Comments	<p>I object to the Planning Application WSCC/030/21 for Loxwood Clay Pits development of Pallinghurst Woods, on the following grounds:</p> <p>HGV lorries will wreck the local roads, which already have a pothole problem.</p> <p>The junction with the A281 is unsuitable for HGV's in large numbers. It will become unsafe.</p> <p>The lorries are too wide for the narrow country lanes, and will cause problems for cars, walkers and cyclists. They will be noisy and leave mud on the road, potentially causing accidents.</p> <p>Ancient woodland is vital for biodiversity. It must be maintained for future generations to learn about and enjoy.</p> <p>Any hedgerows removed will be a loss of habitat for small mammals, birds (including those on the endangered birds list) as well as a loss of safe space for pollinating insects to rest.</p> <p>There should not be such a development in what is a greenfield site. This would be a totally unsuitable place.</p>
