Comments	<p>I am writing to strongly object to the the proposed planning application by Loxwood Clay Pits Limited. The proposed site is wholly unsuitable for the the area as it will necessitate the clearing of mature woodland to create a waste recycling centre without the benefit of any infrastructure to support such an operation. A part of the access to the site runs across farm land used for grazing dairy cows. This proposal will completely change the outlook look and feel of what is currently a very pleasant piece of the Sussex countryside.</p> <p>I believe the proposed plan would adversely affect and dramatically change the mature English woodland.</p> <p>The heavy industrial nature of this business will generate dust from heavy goods vehicles on unmetaled roads to the site. By definition of the materials being brought to site for processing, these will also generate dust and potential odours and will certainly not have any positive impact on what is at this point in time a mature woodland !!</p> <p>The impact of this kind of operation on a green field site can only have a detrimental affect, there can be no justification to site this parcel of land here for this purpose.</p> <p>Industrial operations need fundamental criteria to operate successfully and efficiently. Access to infrastructure, power, water and waste connections, good road access and reasonable distance to market. It is clear that trying to create all this in the middle of a mature wooded area could only ever be detrimental environmentally in pretty much every detail.</p>
