| Comments | There are many valid reasons for disallowing this application and I wish to draw attention to some of the main ones: 1. The WSCC Minerals Monitoring Report says there is no demand for additional brick making clay 2. The site is greenfield and the national policy says waste sites should be in built up areas or brownfield sites. Further more this site is in an area of pristine woodlands and would cause unacceptable impacts on local established farming activity 3. HGVs will run across public Rights of Way and the application proposes the closure of one public footpath. In addition the wheel wash is to be sited on irreplaceable designated Ancient Woodland 4. There will inevitably be a major impact on wildlife habitat and species. 5.The increased heavy traffic on Loxwood Road, which is just over 5 metres wide along most of its route, will have a serious impact on local road users. There is also a severe safety issue with HGVs entering and leaving the junction with the A281 at Bucks Green. | |
