Comments	<p>I object to this development on the following grounds:</p> <p>There is no demand for clay extraction in West Sussex. The WSCC has more than 25 years of reserves.</p> <p>Brick making should take place adjacent to clay extraction; this is clearly not what is being proposed here. This will lead to pollution and environmental damage as well as being uneconomical.</p> <p>The proposed location for the clay and waste pits is presently tranquil and unspoilt. There will be considerable light and noise pollution associated with both the extraction and the traffic movements.</p> <p>There will be an increase in net carbon emissions at a time that these have to be reduced.</p> <p>The increase in HGV traffic will severely impact the local roads and lanes. The proposed site is so obviously not situated in a suitable position to be considered safe or suitable for other road users and pedestrians.</p>
