Comments	<p>As a young resident (20 years old) who has lived locally to the proposed clay pit site for my whole life, I strongly object to this planning application.</p> <p>Firstly, I object on the grounds that the development will destroy the natural habitat in the local area. In particular, I am concerned that trees will be felled which could support roosting bats and birds. I also note that this is described as "ancient woodland" - this should be a protected area which we should preserve, especially as a public footpath runs through the woodland, which I frequently use.</p> <p>Secondly, a plethora of daily HGV traffic (for approximately 33 years) along a minor road is not safe and will pose a severe risk to walkers and school children who wait for the school bus along that road. This will also create pollution, damage to roads, and unnecessary noise for local residents.</p> <p>From researching the local demand for clay, I note that there is not currently a requirement for these supplies. Therefore, there is no justification for creating a clay pit in this area.</p> <p>Thank you for taking the time to consider my objection.</p>
