I strongly object to the proposed commercial waste recycling plant and Claypit development at Pallinghurst Woods, Loxwood, West Sussex for the following reasons:

Reason 1 - Road Safety

The narrow Country lanes are simply not fit for HGVs. They are used by horse riders, bikers, walkers, families with children, all these have been disregarded in the application which has not looked at things from a safety aspect.

There are no suitable paths for pedestrians.

Also there is potential damage to listed buildings and houses along the lanes with HGVs thundering along a speed restricted area blighting all the beautiful cottages and houses along the proposed route.

Reason 2 - Unsuitability

There will be ruination of The Historic tranquil woods themselves a natural environment with its beautiful ancient oak trees, where there are many protected species of Bats, Badgers, Deer, Butterflies, beautiful birds and more.... The proposed development will be ruining an existing wonderful peaceful amenity for locals to walk and enjoy from surrounding villages because of the noise and safety.
