



I have the greatest objection to the planning application WSCC/030/21. My quiet and tranquil home is 100 yards from the junction onto the Loxwood Road from Tismans Common and therefore the noise and pollution engendered by the excess HGV traffic would effect me greatly.

Driving to Rudgwick or Loxwood would become severely hazardous. It is already difficult to turn at that junction and the road is not very wide there. It would cause severe risk and danger to all of us at Tismans Common if this were allowed.

I often walk down the Loxwood Road to the Village and it is already hazardous as some of the pavements are narrow, more traffic especially big lorries would be a real menace to all of us who travel up and down that road. Walkers, cyclists and horse riders included.

Having walked freely in Pallingshurst Woods for over 25 years and enjoyed the peace and tranquility of the area I say "shame on those who wish to destroy trees and wildlife which the government and all of us are trying to protect."

This is a Greenfield site and not in a suitable location for a commercial waste recycling plant and associated clay pits. West Sussex does not need any further clay extraction.

What of the poor threatened species. The bats, the badgers the birds ,insects and rodents and of course the trees and vegetation they rely on?

Please do not allow this dreadful thing to happen to our much appreciated and loved area. I object to every aspect of it.
