Ref: Planning application WSCC/030/21

I am a resident of Alfold Bars and I am horrified to learn that Loxwood Claypits Ltd; have submitted a planning application to develop a commercial waste recycling plant and associated clay pit near Loxwood in the heart of the beautiful and peaceful Pallinghurst woods.

HGVs travelling to and fro from construction and demolition sites will bring their loads to a proposed 1400 square metre purpose built building on this greenfield site for sorting approximately 45 times per day. Once sorted, the HGVs will take the remaining waste elsewhere to be sold. The neighbouring hamlets of Tisman's Common, Rudgwick, Alfold, Alfold Bars and Loxwood will be forever affected having to contend with the associated noise, dust and air pollution, highway safety issues, and potential damage to listed buildings. This development does not conform with the Loxwood Neighbourhood or Chichester District Local Plan for development in rural areas.

This is a precious greenfield site. The increased traffic associated with this proposal would destroy the tranquility of this special place, and would severely damage the environment especially for the wildlife for whom Pallinghurst Woods is home.

At this point in time we should all be working to conserve trees on which we depend to absorb toxic carbon emissions thereby improving the air we all breathe.

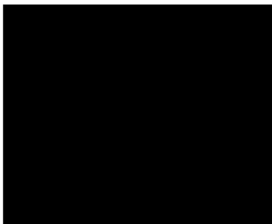
The felling of trees, not only for the benefit of humanity and wildlife should in my opinion be outlawed, permitted only if there is a risk to life or property.
