Comments	<p>I strongly object to this application. Here are two points of objection for your consideration:-</p> <p>1). Public Safety. The access routes planned onto the A281 are via a restricted width lane, either east to Bucks Green or west to Loxwood. The lane in both directions has several blind bends, narrow points, no verges and trees/bushes growing right to lane's edge. The lane is currently very popular with cyclists and often used by horse riders. This is clearly unsuitable for the large-scale HGV traffic required to service the site, it's potentially an accident waiting to happen.</p> <p>2). Tax Payer's Money The lane is clearly not suitable for regular, large scale HGV traffic. The result will be a complete deterioration of the road surface, in particular, the road edges. Our/your experience with Crouchlands where Foxbridge Lane had to be drastically repaired must be learned from. I assume this was at taxpayers' expense, and it was unbelievable that within months, it was all damaged again as more lorries continued to use it - what a waste of money!</p> <p>Please also refer to Knowle Lane (Cranleigh - Waverly Borough) - another lane in the area where an allowed development resulted in heavy HGV traffic on an unsuitable lane. Same result as Foxbridge Lane. Thank you.</p>
