How can anyone expect it to accommodate another 42 (at least) fully loaded trucks every day. There was a pedestrian fatality on this road only last year. Do we want more? The road junction at Bucks Green is difficult enough to get out of in a car and there are regular accidents there. If planning permission is granted there are bound to be more frequent, serious accidents at this spot too as these heavy trucks try to enter the main road.	
	Constant noise will replace the peace and tranquillity of the area in daylight hours. The damage and destruction to the natural environment and wildlife will be immeasurable.
