Comments	<p>Clay Pits situated in Loxwood would cause a severe safety risk due to the dramatically increased HGV traffic along the small roads of adjoining villages which are not designed for such traffic volume or size. As a local resident I already feel extremely anxious walking along the A281 with my two young children when large lorries charge past due to their size and close proximity to us on the narrow pavement.</p> <p>The increased emissions from the aforementioned increase in traffic would be in addition to the increase in net carbon emissions from the development as a whole, at a time when global warming is a key issue across the world and we need to all work fast to slow its rate. The Loxwood development does NOT support this and I fear for the future of our future generations.</p> <p>The proposed site is currently a peaceful and tranquil area, filled with a range of wildlife and bird song. This habitat, to so many animals, would be destroyed and noisy, intrusive vehicles and excavators would replace this area. Furthermore, intrusive lighting would need to be added to pollute the dark night sky of a currently peaceful countryside setting enjoyed by so many.</p> <p>Ultimately, this proposal would be damaging to not only the immediate area but the surrounding and neighbouring villages particularly in terms of damage to the environment, road safety to pedestrians and destruction of wildlife habitats.</p>
