Comments	<p>I object to the Loxwood Clay Pits Ltd planning application in Pallinghurst Woods for the following reasons:</p> <p>The area is a place of natural beauty with beautiful and peaceful walks for people and an undisturbed area for wildlife which would be greatly affected by the plans for clay extraction and, even worse, a commercial waste recycling site. There really is no justification for such a blight on the countryside and I find it incredible that the application is even being considered by WSCC.</p> <p>Footpaths through this lovely countryside would be closed.</p> <p>The increased HGV traffic will impact on the A281 which is already an extremely busy road and it is even more concerning that these lorries will be travelling up and down the Loxwood Road which, at various points, is far too narrow for such large vehicles. Also, leaving Loxwood Road at Bucks Green on to the A281 is hazardous at best of times.</p> <p>Please take account of the impact this highly damaging development would have on the residents of several villages. We are lucky to live in such a beautiful place and it would be so sad to have such an intrusive industrial project inflicted on the area. The demand for clay has diminished and an industrial recycling site should be on a brownfield site and not sited in the middle of tranquil countryside.</p>
