| Comments           | <p>I object to this application for the following reasons.</p> <p>Environmental impact due to the destruction of woodland, increasing use of fossil fuels by the HGVs, thus increasing CO2 emissions is against the outcome of the IPCC report and we have to reduce not increase CO2 emissions now not later.</p> <p>The irreplaceable ancient woodland and wildlife habitat cannot be restored. Whilst endangering protected species in the process</p> <p>This is a water stressed area, plans to use or contaminate would be damaging to existing residents and agriculture.</p> <p>Rikkyo School is in close proximity and the children would suffer from the polluting noise and contaminants in dust blown in their direction, as would any local residents.</p> <p>The road is unsuitable for HGV traffic, both narrow and undulating. It is unpaved for most part and pedestrians who live in the vicinity, some, elderly, would be at risk from so many additional large vehicles. Listed buildings along that road are at risk of damage through vibrations of said HGVs.</p> <p>There is more than sufficient clay available in WSCC sites, no need to dig out anymore, especially as it would be environmentally damaging to transport that clay to a processing site long distance.
