Objection

As previous owners of the above property I have to object to this application for the following reasons:

1. Not only is there no significant shortfall of clay supply, information from longtime residents who can remember previous historic clay extraction suggest that there was an excessive shale content that rendered the clay unsuitable for brick use. Therefore without the premise of clay extraction there is absolutely no justification for a waste dump.

- 2. The noise and dust pollution associated with waste preparation for disposal will be enormous. Enclosing concrete crushers in thin walled buildings will still generate a massive noise disturbance, add to that all the outdoor machinery, diggers trucks and dumpers going from eight in the morning everyday will have a huge impact on the local population's way of life. For what benefit to them?

  3. The public roads over which the proposed twenty round trips every day are wholly unsuitable and we're never designed for such heavy frequent usage. The Loxwood Rudgewick road is already
- damaged and has numerous and significant patch repairs even without the proposed traffic.

  4. The danger to other road users, cyclists and pedestrians that the proposed traffic poses cannot be overstated.
- 5. The ecological disruption both to the amenities the woodlands offer and the wildlife that live within is not justified when there is already proven sufficient waste disposal facilities within the county. For these reasons and more I urge you to to reject this application.
