Objection

I object to the proposed construction of the clay pit and waste recycling facility.

As a disabled member of the community this development would have particular impacts on me. The increased sound from the proposal will negatively impact my life as due to my autism I am hyper sensitive to sensory disruption. Loud noise causes a sensory overload where I can no longer concentrate on the things I'm doing. Even distant loud noise makes an impact. Due to my chronic illness I can only complete my education from home and the additional noise will make it difficult to

The site location is completely contrary to local and national policy. New waste sites should be located in brownfield sites, not greenfield sites with impacts on ancient woodland. This is something you learn in GSCE geography. The extra emissions from importing waste to a site so far from lorry routes (4.8 km on local roads and woodland track) partly defeats the purpose of recycling.

We are in a climate emergency and reversing climate change is of upmost importance. This development will directly harm the local environment and creating emissions from felling veteran trees and disturbing the woodland floor is despicable in the current environmental crisis. We should be protecting greenfield sites that provide vital habitat for wildlife species to thrive, spaces for children to connect with nature and which contribute to improved mental health and wellbeing.
