There is no justification for building the plant and operating a clay extraction and waste recycling and landfill business on this greenfield site when there are clay reserves in West Sussex for the next 25 years and enough more suitable sites already in operation.

The proposed development would have a huge impact on the rural and tranquil character of this area and be detrimental to the woodland and its vast array of flora and fauna. Wildlife habitats and plants would be destroyed and trees felled. It would not be sensitive to the local setting with pollution from lights and motor vehicles continually entering and leaving the site.

There would be no benefit to the local communities as the quiet enjoyment of the woodland would be lost and 43 HGV's leaving and entering the site 6 days a week for over 30 years on dangerous and unsuitable roads would have a devastating effect on the daily lives of residents. Those living along the Loxwood Road to the east towards the A281 would have to bear the brunt of this increased traffic.
