| Comments | <p>the clay pit should be close to the site where it will be used and well-related to the Lorry Route Network (LRN). The site is 10 miles from the Strategic LRN (the A24),2. We do not need the recycling facility (CMRF)?</p> <p>West Sussex Waste Plan, 2014-2031, reviewed in 2019, makes clear there are sufficient CMRF sites (five) in the county, all close to built-up areas, close to the source of the materials. There is in any case a suspicion LCP intend to bring in materials from as far away as the London fringe.</p> <p>. Not only could a CMRF be in an existing quarry or pit, it should be on a brownfield site (this one is greenfield), not only close to the source of waste, but also close to the urban market for recycled materials such as crushed aggregate.</p> <p>The onus is on LCP to show there are no alternative sites available, which they have not done.</p> <p>This is in every respect a sensitive area, it is a mosaic of mixed woodlands, one of UK's "habitats of principal importance", at different stages of maturity, openness and species mix: established Ancient Woodland. Therefore the potential noise, emissions, habitat disturbance, visual intrusion and impact on Ancient Woodland is not viable.</p> |
